



The Hampstead Old Town Hall is circled

Local pay-and-display parking facilities are very limited and are subject to varying maximum time limits so we recommend you use public transport.

By bus:

- 168 from Elephant & Castle and Hampstead
- C11 from Brent Cross and Archway
- 268 from Golders Green Bus Station and Finchley Road O2 Centre

By underground:

Nearest Underground station is **Belsize Park** on the **Northern Line**. From the station turn right and walk about 150 metres up the hill until you reach the pelican crossing over Haverstock Hill. Cross the road here and Hampstead Old Town Hall is in front of you and to your right.

By rail:

Nearest station (**Hampstead Heath**) served by the **London Overground** is about 10-15 minutes walk to the Old Town Hall, partly uphill. Exiting the station (fruit stall on your left) cross South End Road by the zebra crossing in front of you. Turn left and walk past the bus stand and ornamental seating area on your left until you reach the corner opposite M&S and the flower stall. Turn right at this corner and walk up Pond Street, with The Royal Free Hospital on your left, until you reach the traffic lights at the top and next to St Stephen's Church. At this junction with Rosslyn Hill, turn left to Haverstock Hill. Walk past the taxi rank and the Rosary School on your left. Continue until you reach the second pelican crossing, which is opposite Hampstead Old Town Hall. **Those who prefer not to walk from the station should take the 168 bus from the bus stand** two stops to the Belsize Park tube station stop. Buses run every 5 mins or so.

If you are going to travel by Underground or Overground please check whether there are any maintenance works taking place the weekend of 9/10 October 2010 and plan your travel accordingly.
