

Summer School Booking Notes. Royal Agricultural College Cirencester.

Summer School 1 Monday 16 to Thursday 19 August 2010

Summer School 2 Monday 23 to Thursday 26 August 2010

1. One form to be completed by each applicant – married couples please complete one form per person.
2. The ‘first’ name you provide will be the one to appear on your name badge.
3. Booking courses: Only put a 2nd or 3rd course if you are prepared to do it as you will automatically be assigned your 2nd/3rd choice if your other choices are full. You will be put on a waiting list for your 1st subject if you do not put any alternative courses. You cannot mix courses. Some courses may have to be cancelled if there are insufficient numbers.
4. Accommodation: Single student bedrooms with en-suite facilities arranged on 2/3 floors in villas a short walk from the tutorial rooms. Towels and complimentary tea/coffee facilities are provided. There are a few double & twin bedded rooms which will be allocated on “a first-come first-served basis”. You will automatically be given a single bedded room if double and twin bedded rooms are no longer available.
5. Ground floor rooms are limited and must be pre-booked. Lifts: there are no lifts in either the bedroom or teaching areas.
6. Travel: The College is in a rural location & public transport is infrequent. However, there is a shop on site at the Royal Agricultural College and it is possible to walk into Cirencester from the college. The station for Cirencester is Kemble which is a short taxi ride (4 miles) from the college.
7. Registration on Monday (approximately 2.30-5pm). The Schools start after registration and close after lunch on Thursday.
8. Extra accommodation for the night before & after each School is available for £38 per person per night bed & breakfast. It can be booked when you send in the outstanding balance next April.
9. Payment: Cheques are payable to ‘The Third Age Trust’. Please write School 1 or School 2 and the name of your course on the reverse of all cheques. To keep costs down we do not send reminders but will write if final balances are outstanding early in May.
10. Payment terms: £70 deposit to be sent with application form and balance paid by 30th April 2010. After this date we cannot refund deposits.
11. Any other refunds after 30/04/2010 will be made at The Third Age Trust’s discretion and we regret we cannot make refunds for cancellation (or non-attendance) within four weeks of the Summer School’s starting date.

We would strongly recommend that you consider taking out holiday insurance to cover this.
